Osteosarcomas in of long bones most commonly occur in young adults, where-as jaw\_osteosarcomas of the jaw\_usually occur at a present at a later age group (mean age of 34-to\_36 years). OHead and neck osteosarcomas of the head and neck behave distinctly from those that of of long bones. Remmelink M-et\_al, in his in vitro studies showed that, osteosarcoma cell lines may be affected by sex steroids;- but however, this effect was not related to the gender origin of the cell line. In our case, the patient presented to our hospital two-2 months after the development of <u>a</u> swelling. Delayed presentation may be attributed to the lack of signs and symptoms, the use of local remedies, religious attitudes, and the lack of interest on part of by the patient. Osteosarcomas of the mMandibularle osteosarcomas can cause early compression of the underlying nerve, leading to paraesthesias and numbness in the lower lip. Our patient also had numbress and <u>a tingling sensation in the lower lip. Early</u> diagnosis and aggressive radical resection plays a key roles in achieving high survival rates. In our case, wide local excision with segmental mandibulectomy was selected opted-as a reconstruction.
